



## Kansas City Southern Road Number KCS 9027

This 70' husky stack well car is brown with white lettering and runs on ASF Ride Control Trucks. Built in 1996, this 9001-9100 series Kansas City Southern well car accepted containers up to 48' in length in its bottom well position. The Husky-Stack® well car was first introduced in 1990 at the International Intermodal Expo in Atlanta, GA.

## Southern Road Number SOU 43492



This 60' excess height box car with double plug doors and waffle sides is brown with white lettering and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Still operating in its original paint today, it was built in the late 1970s by Berwick and was designed for Auto Parts service with Ford.

These 53' corrugated containers are blue with white lettering. UMAX is an interline container service jointly owned by CSX® and Union Pacific®, with a fleet of more than 40,000 intermodal containers. Often found on the top position of 48' well cars, these 110" tall Jindo built units are truly ubiquitous across the United States rail network.





## Norfolk Southern Road Number NS 655903



This 60' excess height box car with double plug doors and waffle sides is brown with white lettering and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Built by Berwick in late 1978 for Conrail, it was later transferred to Norfolk Southern through mergers. As a high-cube car, it exceeds Plate F dimensions and was designed for Auto Parts service with Ford, and later General Motors. It now wears the NS "no-stripe" paint scheme.


## Great Northern Road Number GN 35729

This 50' standard box car with double doors is red with white lettering and runs on Bettendorf trucks. This car was built in August 1957 for Great Northern Railway as part of series 35500-35749. The GN was founded in 1899 and soon became a large network from the Midwest to the Pacific Coast. The railroad merged with Northern Pacific to become Burlington Northern in 1970.
