While the railroad was known for massive coal trains, N&W also ran many passenger trains between Norfolk and Columbus as well as other routes on the east coast. This BMF class mail baggage car had black ends and extended door reinforcement plates.

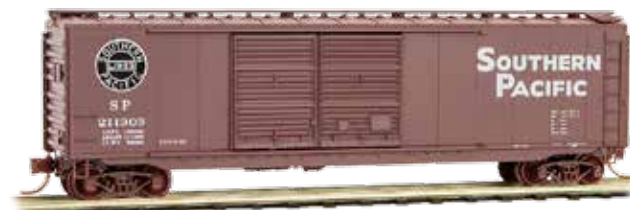

Built to meet the growing demand for larger door openings which permitted ease of use for forklifts and larger loading devices. In the spring of 1953 PFE® repainted 50 of the 4700 R-40-10 refrigerator cars for express service. The cars were then classed as BR-40-10. They were numbered 901 through 950. The cars selected had been overhauled in 1951 and 1952 and given electric fans and steel running boards. The first 25 cars were given Chrysler FR-5-D trucks while the last 25 received Symington-Gould Type XL.
